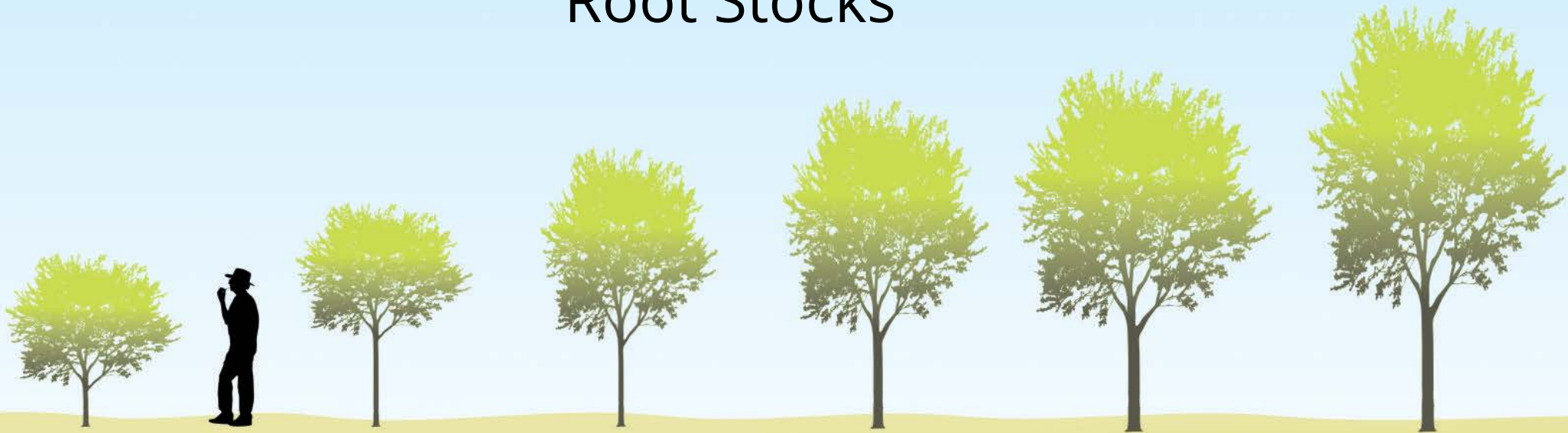

Notes

There is no set pattern to the various root stock names and numbers as they are product of various field trials over the years to find the most useful root stocks for a variety.

Hawthorn, Pear and Medlar are all compatible with each other.

The root stock will determine the ultimate size of tree and usually maintains it in proportion i.e. the smaller the tree the smaller the fruit.
